GAC places students 21 years and older into a flexible instructional program to work on obtaining a high school diploma.

Orientation for GAC

Orientation is held at Dawson Orman on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. The student will complete paperwork and take an entrance exam, which covers math and reading.

Independent Study

This is a correspondence program that allows students to work at their own pace. Students have 120 days to complete the course. Once the coursework has been completed, the student must take a proctored final exam at Dawson Orman. There is a \$25 textbook fee for each course. Once the textbook has been returned, a refund check will be issued to the student for the full amount. If you have any other questions, please call (502) 485-3046.

JCPSeSchool

This online program allows students to earn credits from home. Students have 120 days to complete each course. Once the coursework has been completed, the student must take a proctored final exam at Dawson Orman. JCPSeSchool allows students to communicate with a teacher via email or phone. When the student is enrolled through the GAC program, there is not a fee for JCPSeSchool. If you have any other questions, please call (502) 485-7800.
